



Frequently Asked Questions for Exhortation Request

1. What should I do if I want to alert the church of a death, illness, hospital stay, or prayer request?

Call Eastern Star Church immediately at (317) 591-5050 Ext. 140 to provide them with your contact information. If no one answers the phone, please leave a message and someone will return your call as soon as possible.

2. Who can submit an Exhortation Request?

Members of Eastern Star Church and/or family members can submit an Exhortation Request.

3. Who do I call to submit an Exhortation Request?

Call the Eastern Star Church at (317) 591-5050 Ext. 140.

4. When should I call to alert the church of a death, illness, hospital stay, or prayer request?

When you are ready to inform the church about a death, illness, hospital stay, or seeking prayer, call the Eastern Star Church Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

5. What happens after the request is submitted?

After the request form is completed, the form is distributed to the Exhortation Ministry, Exhortation Manager, and Church Administration, and Church Council.

6. Will my information be placed in the Eastern Star Church weekly bulletin?

Information will be placed in the weekly bulletin only if the member indicates request it.

7. How can I serve in the Exhortation Ministry?

You must be a member of Eastern Star Church, complete a training program, and attend a monthly meeting. Recruitment for the Exhortation Ministry begins will be announced via church announcements, website, or social media.
